Other activities were also accomplished however others are still on waiting.

Administratively

In this month we have worked on few areas within the Administration only communications, however other utilities were not yet paid due to financial breakdown and are still pending.

we are Luckily that the health standards /wellbeing of our kids are now improving and the skin infections rate have so far reduced with only few still with scars unlike the past months and are still on medication so as to get completely out of it. And we are trying hard to provide with them immune boosters, fruits and different food varieties for the health living.

we have few major cases of Naume who needs the operation and Sempija Joselyne with heart related issues here by according to medical report she needs to be on medication as they keep on monitoring her situation.

Other cases we have registered so far are minor including stomach pain, fever but all were managed and kids are doing well.

Education

All the schooling kids are now in holidays and some of them are residing at the center and some of the agape learning kids are on holiday coaching so as to keep them active in classes. However, all the candidate students have already reported back for school holiday coaching so as they prepare in time for their final end of level exams.

2 vocational students remained at school doing their training these are;

However, most of the Agape Children here resettled as per our programs and we support them with tuition fees in schools and after schools most of them connect with their next of kin or relatives.

Welfare

we managed to stock small food stocks and other few home supplies for the immediate use however the number of kids we have has increased and we have to be providing them with breakfast, lunch and dinner so far, we have 26 kids residing at the center that we care for, these include the ones we have been having previously, those from boarding section during school days and vocational students.



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CHALLENGES

1. **Rent:** we still have rent arrears of May, June, July and August have been mostly focusing clearing the tuition fees for the students so as they can concentrate in their academics and also their clearing medical bills for those how got sick in the last months.

any money we received in July on rent hence giving the landlords children to always disturb our peace in need of their rent money.
2. **Salary/ wages:** with the financial breakdown we have been through this month, we couldn't manage paying the salaries for July the only money we received we stocked few food staffs and other immediate items to use.
3. **Food stock:** The food store is also running out of stock since we had stocked few food items due to the financial crisis and also due to increased number of kids we have so far at the center, all these we provide them with breakfast, lunch and supper plus the additional home supplies.
4. **Holiday studies:** All the students in the candidate class would be seating for their final National Examination in the coming school term and are reporting back on 01/09/2025 for coaching and they charge some fee for feeding and teachers allowances
5. **Utility bills** we still have the pending balances for the utility bills on water
6. **School fees and school requirements:** As some schools are starting on 1st /9/2025, 7th/9/2025, 12th/9/2025 and 15th/9/2025 school fees stands first that the school needs to have and it's now that we are to start preparing them for third term with school requirements and tuition fees since this is the promotional school term and is very short.
